HVLT Firewise Roadside Neighborhood Chipper Program

HVLT Firewise, in collaboration with Southern Marin Fire, is offering roadside chipping of shrub, brush, branches and small trees for Homestead residents.

- For limbs and small trees: 8" maximum diameter
- Minimum total pile size: 6' x 5' x 4'
- Piles must be able to remain in place days or weeks until chipper is available
- NO ivy, NO poison oak, NO broom

Curbside Chipping Program:

- 1. Contact firewise@hvlt.org or your Neighborhood Block Contact to propose a roadside location where a pile can safely remain for days or weeks
- 2. A HVLT Firewise team member confirms location with an HVLT Firewise sandwich board
- 3. Pile limbs and small trees with all thick side/trunk orientated to street
- 4. Contact firewise@hvlt.org or your Neighborhood Block Contact when pile is ready for chipping
